General Dress Code: All students are expected to follow the dress code while on TTC premises. If a student is out of dress code, they will not be allowed to attend class. The student will be required to call a parent and wait in the front lobby until they receive a change of clothes. When they are dressed according to the dress code policy, they may attend their next class. They cannot, however, interrupt the class they were dismissed from.

This dress code will be **strictly enforced**, so please double-check your child's attire before leaving the house. Teachers have the right to remove student from the class for any dress code violation.

A Training Center shirt must be worn by all students while on campus. Both the short sleeved t-shirt and long sleeved t-shirt is acceptable. The Training Center logo must be visible.

Girls

- _ Skirts may be worn; however they must be knee length and have slits no higher than 2 inches above the knee.
- _ Leggings are allowed to be worn under dresses or pants. They are not to be worn otherwise.
- _ Capri pants may be worn, however, no shorts will be allowed.

Guys

- _ No athletic or elastic banded shorts may be worn, however, standard knee-length shorts are acceptable.
- _ Pants & jeans should be on or near the waist.

All

- _ The Training Center shirt, jeans, pants, shorts or skirts should not fit tightly.
- _ Sweat pants should NOT be worn.
- _ Pants and jeans should be in good repair and fit property, not baggy or tight.
- _ No low-rise apparel is allowed. No underwear should show at anytime.
- _ All teachers have the right to ask that hats or caps be removed while in their classroom.
- _ Pull-over sweatshirts and sweaters may **NOT** be worn. Zip-up or button-up sweatshirts, jackets, and sweaters, with or without hoods may be worn as long as they are free from graphics and writing. TTC has hooded, zip-up sweatshirts for sale which meet dress code approval.
