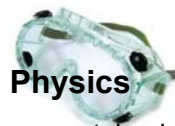


# 2018 - 2019 Revelation Science

## High School Supply List – Geology/Astronomy, Bio, Chem, Anatomy, Physics



NOTE: Notebooks are an integral part of your science class. A handout on how to organize your notebook is given at Orientation, so you can put it together and have it ready for the first day of class.

**Notebooks are evaluated in the Fall and Spring.**

- Safety goggles – REQUIRED FIRST CLASS – 1 pair - \*\*\*\*VITAL TO BE CORRECT\*\*\*\***  
BIO, CHEM, & ANATOMY - Chemical splash goggles to go over glasses; **MUST HAVE** side shields, seal to face, & have **INDIRECT** ventilation. GEO/ASTRO & PHYSICS - Impact resistant goggles with Z87 rating that go over glasses; **MUST HAVE** side shields, & seal to face. Students bring goggles to our **FIRST** class with their initials on them. Goggles stay at the lab until the end of year, then are returned. (*Highly recommend Chem get both type.*)
- 3” – 3.5” three-ring binder** (For all school work done at home and in class.) 3.5” works best for Bio & Chem
- 16 Dividers** (The notebook grade includes neatness, so consider this, especially about labels staying put.)
- 3 packages of notebook paper & 1 ream of computer paper – SET ASIDE FOR USE FOR OUR CLASS**
- 3 rolls of Paper Towels** - Bring rolls to first class and turn in to teacher.
- Index cards** (4x6 – either lined or not lined. They are used for reference cards to use in each course.)
- 4 - Red pens** (REQUIRED to have in your notebook.)
- Pencils** for school work and lab class (Mechanical type preferred due to no need for pencil sharpener.)
- Pencil bag for 3-ring binder** (In the front for writing tools, blank index cards, companion CD, & calculator.)
- Photo Pages** (For reference cards - 4x6. Ones that allow cards to all be horizontal work better.) Try [Office Depot](#) & [On-line](#)
- Calculator** (A basic \$1 calculator is needed for **geo/astro, bio, & anatomy**. A **scientific** calculator is **required** for **chem & physics**. Students must bring it to EACH class & know how to operate it. It is essential to have for school work & available for each class. Calculators can be stored in pencil bag, so keep this in mind when buying.)
- Sheet protectors** (Minimum of 5 – Additional ones may be wanted for certain handouts.)  
*Curriculum links are to Apologia, so you can see what they look like. CBD generally offers better pricing.*

(For clarification, there are 3 CDs available. The companion or supplemental CD, which is needed for class, an audio CD where the text is read to the student, and a CD that has the textbook and solutions manual on it.)
